Work Experience and Skill Training

Gardening and Grounds Maintenance

There are many roles within the Growability team, providing participants with a range of experiences, roles and development.

- Lawn mowing and lawn care
- Garden maintenance, improvements and upkeep
- Weeding, pruning, trimming, fertilising, weed controlling
- Leaf blowing, branch and waste removal
- Planting and gardening

Participants will receive training and experience in:

- Equipment including lawn mowers, leaf blowers, whipper snippers, hedging and edging tools, wheel barrows, etc.
- Customer service
- Work Health and Safety Training
- Opportunity to receive further qualifications in horticulture with TAFE NSW
