The Windgap Foundation is a not-for-profit organisation, started by a group of parents over 65 years ago in the Eastern Suburbs of Sydney, to provide education to their children with intellectual disabilities who were refused schooling.

Today, Windgap has grown to support 250 families in the community, providing a range of vital programs and services to support and empower adults from 18 to over 80 years old, including supported employment, shared living homes, school leavers and life skill programs, NDIS support coordination, and community participation in both sport and leisure.

At Windgap we believe that everyone should have the opportunity to achieve their goals and enjoy the life they want to live.

## Volunteering Opportunities at Windgap

We have a range of volunteer opportunities for you and your teams to get involved in:



### Work with our Supported Employees

Our purpose built warehouse is one of our Australian Disability Enterprises (ADE) and provides supported employment to adults with intellectual disabilities.

There are many roles and opportunities within our warehouse, providing our Supported Employees with a range of jobs and skill development. Volunteers can support our teams with picking and packing, boxing up of stock and quality control.

### Day Program and School Leavers Support

At Windgap, our Day Programs provide an opportunity for adults with intellectual disabilities to actively participate in a range of recreational, sport and community activities.

Volunteer teams could be involved in anything from art classes, outdoor BBQs, sporting matches, choir group, cooking classes or technology training.

*Volunteers limit: Up to 4 volunteers per day program (total of 20)*
